PLACEMENT OVERVIEW

Fellowship Position Title: Partnerships & Development Fellow

Fellowship Position Summary: The Partnerships & Development Fellow will work to strengthen partnerships with college campuses within the Bonner Network, as well as engage in program development, research projects, and public relations/community outreach. The Fellow will be developing a model of engagement for CKP and Bonner schools, identifying target schools and points of contact, researching the service work at each school and proposing how a Campus Kitchen may fit in. In terms of research, the Fellow will conduct reviews of relevant journals on service, hunger, and strategic partnerships in order to write and submit a white paper for publication in partnership with the CEO. The Fellow will also be drafting pieces (with the PR team) for publication and outreach purposes.

Specific Position Activities:

- 1) create a model of engagement and process that would allow CKP to open new Campus Kitchens at Bonner institutions;
- 2) research and write materials for outreach/publication in journals highlighting service; and
- 3) assist in the development of PR materials and outreach.
