PLACEMENT OVERVIEW

Fellowship Position Title: Diversity Initiative Fellow

Fellowship Position Summary: The Diversity Initiative Fellow will work with the Manager of National Alliances to determine the return on investment (ROI) of all diversity recruitment partnerships with TFA. The Fellow will work to develop a program that will directly impact the goals and objectives of TFA's pipeline partnerships included those aimed at low-income populations. The Fellow will also have the opportunity to partner with the entire National Alliance team including the Managing Director on other special projects.

Specific Position Activities:

- 1) conduct case study and needs analyses of new and existing National Alliances Team partnerships;
- 2) research and collaborate with management on a consortium model for supporting first-generation and/or low-income students;
- 3) research and develop framework for the Diversity Partnership Conference; and
- 4) develop conference overview, timeline, budget, logistics, potential venues, etc.
