Fellowship Position Title: Social Entrepreneurship Fellow

Fellowship Position Summary: The Social Entrepreneurship Fellow will work closely with Teach on the Beach management to identify and pursue opportunities to build the organization, which includes work on its participation in the Bonner Global Village Network. Teach on the Beach believes in the Bonner Global Village program and has actively promoted it at campuses its has connected with/visited. The Fellow must work with the TOB team and Global Village Coordinator at the Bonner Foundation to promote the idea in the Network among incoming Scholars so they are informed on TOB’s summer of service opportunities. In addition to building the partnership with Bonner the Fellow will work to identify and collaborate with other organizations, investors and programs that share in the mission of Teach on the Beach.

REQUIRED SKILLS

Self-motivated - must be able to work independently on projects, asking for guidance/help when needed, but ultimately showing ownership of work; Familiarity with grant-writing process and/or writing grant proposals; Knowledge of content management systems, some ability with HTML/CSS, simple photo and video editing

PREFERRED EXPERIENCES

Fellows studying education or doing service with children in schools or after school programs will not only fit well with the Teach on the Beach team, but will also benefit greatly from working with us. Fellows with marketing or business backgrounds will also inherently pick up the financial bottom line aspect of our organization and be an invaluable asset to our growth.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR THIS POSITION

AmeriCorps (NO): This position is ineligible for AmeriCorps, due to its international focus.

Funding: We have asked all sites to consider providing extra funding for Bonner Fellows to reach a target of \$3500 per Fellow for the summer. Check with your Bonner Director and Coordinator to determine if you have any Bonner Scholar or Leader funds that could be used to assist your living costs for this summer. You may need to raise some or all of these funds on your own.

Housing: You will need to relocate to New York City. Fellows are expected to secure and manage their own housing for the duration of the term.
