Study Abroad

When studying abroad, Bonners have two options: to serve while abroad or go on leave. If you want to go on leave, please notify Bryan. If you wish to serve while abroad, here are three helpful documents:

1. The [Volunteering Abroad](#) spreadsheet lists UR's 64 international university partners and provides the contact information of the volunteer coordinator at the universities.
2. [So You Want to Do Service Abroad](#) details how to prepare for going abroad.
3. [Service Abroad Application](#) must be completed before beginning service.

Summer Service

Bonners are responsible for submitting the required paperwork by the specified date.

Hour Log, due August 15
Summer Service Agency Evaluation 2009, due August 15

Federal Work Study (FWS)


