Fellowship Position Title: Education and Outreach Fellow

Fellowship Position Summary: Aquinas Center's Companions on the Journey Project provides support for immigrants living in South Philadelphia in order to increase quality of life outcomes for these individuals and families. The Education and Outreach Fellow will conduct outreach with the local Latin American community to develop and then help deliver an English literacy based summer camp for children and youth. The Fellow will develop volunteer applications, marketing materials, intake forms, and program evaluation plan, as well as assist in designing the camp curriculum. In addition, the Fellow will support volunteer camp staff during the day to day operation, research funding opportunities for future programming, and maintain thorough records for grant reports.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- 1) Conduct outreach with the local Latin American community to develop an English literacy-based summer camp for youth;
- 2) Develop volunteer applications, marketing materials, intake forms, and program evaluation plans;
- 2) Assist in designing camp curriculum;
- 3) Support volunteer campu staff during day to day operations; and
- 4) research funding opportunities for future programming and maintain thorough records for grant reports.

Mission Statement: Aquinas Center seeks to be a vibrant space where people come together to practice hospitality, promote education, and engage in service in order to foster mutual support and shared understanding across cultures.

Organizational Goals: Aquinas Center seeks to equip our immigrant neighbors with the legal and language resources they need to advocate for themselves and their families. Communities experience many challenges related to local and national immigration policies, limited access to education, unfair employment practices, substandard housing, and domestic violence. As a result, Aquinas Center activities include: ESL classes for adults and children; home visiting; one on one legal guidance and topical seminars; after school tutoring, a literacy focused summer camp for children of newly arrived immigrants; and accompaniment for hospital visits, immigration related court appearances, and school conferences. Aquinas Center strives to provide services that are inclusive, relevant, and accountable to the people receiving the support.
