Launched in 2009, the Bonner Advisory Board (BAB) is a cohort of current Bonner student leaders that give their voice to the Bonner Network. BAB members oversee Bonner Congress and work with the Bonner Foundation throughout the year to provide input on programs and policies. The Bonner Advisory Board looks for Bonner students who have attended at least one national meeting (SLI or Bonner Congress), have leadership experience on campus, and embrace the vision and mission of the Bonner Program. During their full year of service, accepted members oversee the national meetings, participate in monthly conference calls with the Bonner Foundation staff, and facilitate other Network initiatives such as the Big Idea Project.
